



Volunteer Firefighter Application Period Open Fire Academy to be Held in Spring

Larkspur CO -- Applications are now being accepted for the position of volunteer firefighter at Larkspur Fire Protection District. The application period is open through March 31st. Successful applicants will have the opportunity to earn a Firefighter 1 certificate, the basic certification required of firefighters in Colorado. "Anyone 18 or older who wants to give something back to their community and learn new skills is welcome to apply," says Lt. Calvin Brown, Training Lieutenant and Volunteer Coordinator. Brown says current plans call for the academy to begin in May, running 14-16 weeks with classes two nights a week and every other Saturday.
